SEARCH TIPS RESERVE AND RENEW BOOKS

Login with your ID Number and Password:

ID Number: full barcode on your student ID/library borrowers' card

Password: last four digits of the ID Number

TO RESERVE A LOANABLE ITEM:

1. Login, search for the item, then select required item(s) from search results list by ticking box to the left of the title
2. Select 'Reserve' button
3. On the next screen, select 'Reserve' icon

TO RENEW ITEMS ALREADY ON LOAN TO YOU:

1. Login, select 'My Account'
2. Select 'Loans'
3. Select 'renew' button to right of the listed item
4. or select 'Renew all loans'

When first enrolled, library users will receive an email enabling them to set up their OpenAthens login.

BORROWING POLICY

- General collection books may be borrowed for 28 days, or a shorter period set if item is in high demand.

- On-site borrowers should present their ID cards in order to borrow items.
